

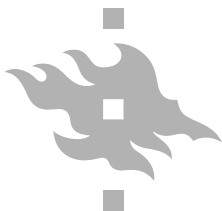

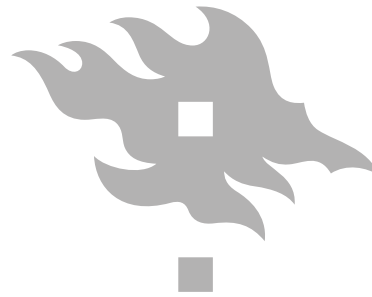

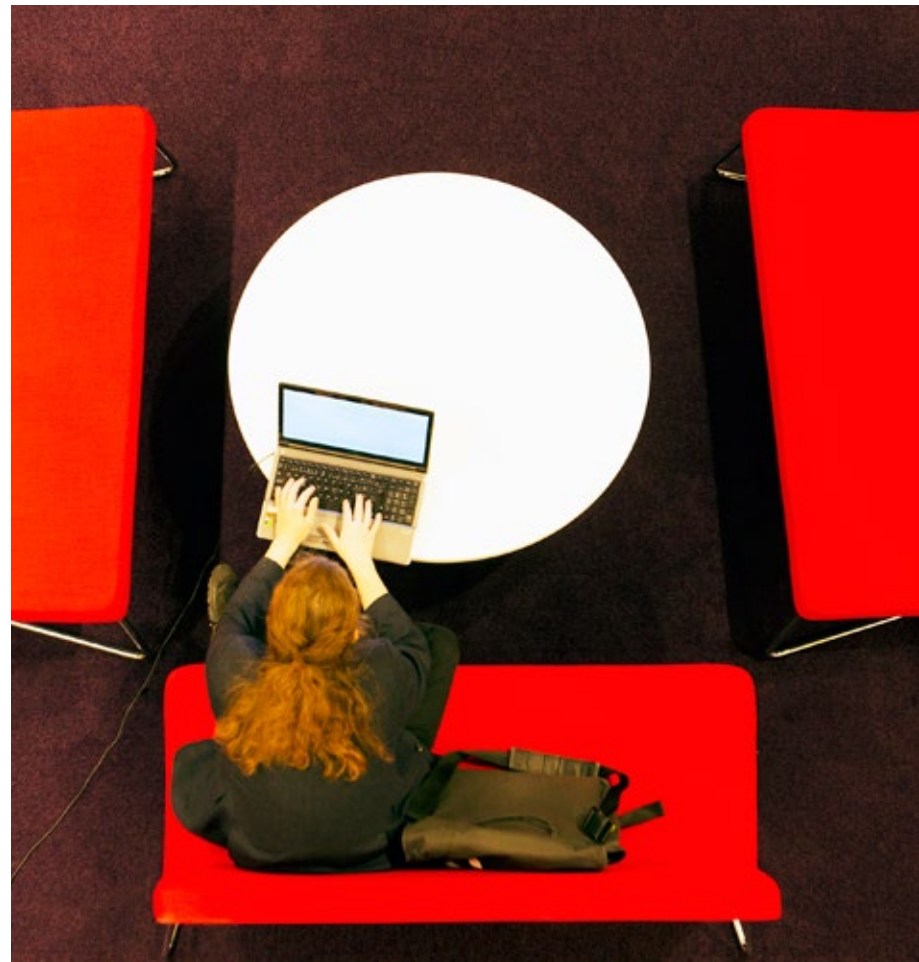

ROOM FOR INFORMATION LEARNING INSPIRATION

When you find yourself in need of expert customer service, high-quality information skills training or help with questions concerning information seeking, the Helsinki University Library is at your disposal. It is the largest multidisciplinary university library in Finland, operating on four different campuses as well as online.

The campus libraries and the library's joint services are responsible for the information and library services for research and learning at the University of Helsinki. A significant part of the services are available online as electronic publications and as tailored web services.

- **The City Centre Campus Library** in Kaisa House is a diverse centre of humanities and social sciences information.
- **The Kumpula Campus Library** specialises in information services in mathematics and natural sciences.
- **The Meilahti Campus Library Terkko** offers information on health and medical sciences.
- **The Viikki Campus Library** is responsible for information services in biological and environmental sciences, agriculture and forestry as well as pharmacy and veterinary medicine.

KUMPULA CAMPUS LIBRARY FOR VISITS AND WORK

The Kumpula Campus Library offers scientific material and information services to students, researchers and science enthusiasts in general.

ONLINE MATERIAL AND SERVICES

The Campus Library gives you access to all of the Helsinki University Library's databases, electronic books and electronic journals. You can search for, order and borrow material online. The virtual ResearchGuides provide field- and discipline-specific services, and present new publications.

To gain access to the electronic material you need a University of Helsinki username and password or a temporary user ID. You can use the material on your own device or on the Library's computers for clients. The University's staff and students also have remote access to the material.

COLLECTIONS

The Library's collections include University of Helsinki Faculty of Science textbooks, theses and dissertations, as well as books, journals and series relevant to the Campus's fields of science.

You can obtain a library card at the Library service desk. Material borrowed from a Helsinki University Library location can be returned to any campus library.

TRAINING AND GUIDANCE FOR INFORMATION SEARCHES

We offer guidance for information searches and help clients find and use material. You may also make an appointment for individual guidance in broader searches.

The Library's courses on information searches are open to all, and provide the skills and tools for finding, evaluating and managing scientific information.



SUPPORT FOR STUDIES AND RESEARCH

The Library offers students a modern learning environment including material and devices, as well as versatile work spaces and areas for groups.

In cooperation with the departments, the Library provides training in information searching suitable for inclusion in the Faculty's teaching.

The research services, in addition to providing materials, focus on supporting and promoting the visibility of open science. What this means is that the Library supports the open storage of data and publications. The Library's experts also provide scientific communities with services related to the evaluation of research and the management of research material.

FACILITIES AND ACCESSIBILITY

The Kumpula Campus Library can be accessed from the lobby of the Physicum building, and is accessible to wheelchair users. A lift goes to the top floor where you can find an electric height-adjustable desk and an accessible toilet.

KUMPULA CAMPUS – THE LARGEST CLUSTER OF NATURAL SCIENCE RESEARCH IN THE NORDIC COUNTRIES

The Kumpula Campus is home to the University of Helsinki's Faculty of Science. Its research-centred units include the Helsinki Institute of Physics (HIP), the Helsinki Institute for Information Technology (HIIT) and the Finnish Institute for Verification of Chemical Weapons Convention (VERIFIN).

The LUMA Centre in Kumpula supports the teaching and learning of mathematics, natural sciences and technology in schools.

The Finnish Meteorological Institute is located in the Dynamicum building.

A UniSport sports centre is also located on the Campus.

The bus or tram takes you from the Central Railway Station to Kumpula in 20 minutes.
