Applying as a Visiting Student at the Faculty of Theology

Throughout the year
The only fee to be paid is the Student Union fee as follows:

- Bachelor / Master's level Studies:
43e/one semester, 86e/one academic year
- Doctoral / PhD students:
22e/one semester, 44/one academic year

The duration of the stay

- Visiting Student status can be granted to both undergraduate and postgraduate level students enrolled and actively studying at a university outside Finland. The prerequisite is that the students are able to transfer any credits completed at the University of Helsinki to the degree programme at their home institution. The status is usually granted for the maximum of one year at a time. During the period of visiting student studies the student cannot graduate from the Faculty. Read more here and how to apply:
