Field study opportunities in Sudan and Ethiopia Funding announcement by the ESUFI Forest project!!

The ESUFI project, which is funded by the CIMO N-S-S programme, announces the availability of funding for four students for field studies in Sudan and Ethiopia. The funding of mobility of students among partner institutions is one of the main activities of the ESUFI Forest project. The funding covers the necessary travel, accommodation, and subsistence costs for three months. Priority will be given for VITRI students.

Conditions for applying for funding for field studies in Ethiopia and Sudan

1. The applicant should be an M.Sc. student registered at the University of Helsinki.
2. The applicant should be advanced in his/her M.Sc. studies.
3. The applicant should be willing and ready to carry out his/her M.Sc. thesis field work (data collection) in Sudan or Ethiopia.
4. In connection with field work students are obliged to participate in a course, which will be held in Ethiopia in June, 2012.
5. The applicant should be willing to work in an environment, where basic services are rudimentary.

The deadline for submission of the application is **15th of February, 2012**. Applicants should fill in the **application form** and send it to the address indicated below; additional information also can be requested from the same address.
