Field study opportunities in Zimbabwe Funding announcement by the ZAOSOR project!!

The ZAOSOR (Zimbabwe Aids Orphans Society-Reforestation) project, which is funded by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland, announces the availability of funding for two M.Sc. students for field studies in Zimbabwe. The funding covers the necessary travel and subsistence costs for three months. The potential field study topics are: forest plantations and agroforestry. VITRI is a partner in the ZAOSOR project and priority will be given for VITRI students.

Conditions for applying for funding for field studies in Zimbabwe

1. The applicant should be an M.Sc. student registered at the University of Helsinki.
2. The applicant should be advanced in his/her M.Sc. studies.
3. The applicant should be willing and ready to carry out his/her M.Sc. thesis field work (data collection) in Zimbabwe starting at the beginning of April 2012.
4. The applicant should be willing to work in an environment, where basic services are rudimentary.

The deadline for submission of the application is **30th of October, 2011**. Applicants should fill in the **application form** and send it to the address indicted below; additional information also can be requested from the same address.
