Arrival and transportation

When arriving in Helsinki Airport it is easy to get to the city centre.


We recommend taking the **train** from the airport to the city centre. Local trains I and P operate between Helsinki Airport and the city centre on the Ring Rail Line every 5–20 minutes. The journey takes 30 minutes. A regional ABC ticket is required and costs 4,10 euro. You can buy the ticket on the **HSL app** or in one of the ticket machines.

You can also take a **taxi**, follow the taxi signs when exiting from the luggage claim. You can read more about the taxi fares **on their website**. To order a taxi in Helsinki, call +3581000700.

When you have arrived in the city centre, everything is within walking distance (10–20 minutes). Of course, **public transport** is also available and easy to use; Helsinki has trams, metro and busses. You can find more information on the **HSL website**.

Venues

Meetings take place in the University of Helsinki's **Main Building** (1), NB: entrance from Unioninkatu side due to construction. The Student Board also convenes in the Old Student House (3). Una Europa Talk and the launch of Una Europa MOOC 'AI in Society' will take place in **Think Corner** (2).



Internet


Eduroam is an international academic public network. If you already have an eduroam user account at your home university, you can use the same account in the eduroam network at the University of Helsinki.

Dinner, 1 June

Departure for dinner on 1 June will take place from **Think Corner** (Yliopistonkatu 4) soon after the Una Europa Talk. Transportation to dinner will be by boat. The boat departs from Kauppatori Market Square (1) and the cruise lasts approximately 45 minutes before arriving at the restaurant. Please make sure you are in Think Corner by 18:00 for the departure and that you have warm clothes for the cruise.

Dinner will take place in **Restaurant Saaristo** on Klippan Island, starting 19:30. After the dinner, a quick ferry will transport participants to the Kaivopuisto shore (2). To return to the city centre, you can either walk (1,5 km, 20 minutes), take a **taxi** or use **public transportation** (trams 2 and 3).
