

Call for applications for the academic year 2019-2020:

Erik Allardt Fellowship HCAS

promoting strong academic and cultural exchange between Finland and Sweden within a context of high quality research in the social and human sciences

The Helsinki Collegium for Advanced Studies offers a residential fellowship for one or two scholars having an affiliation with a university in Sweden for the academic year 2019-2020. Candidates may come from any discipline within the humanities and the social sciences. Early career as well as senior scholars are welcome to apply. The application may be for the entire academic year or alternatively for one academic semester.

The holder of the fellowship receives a monthly grant of 3 500 euros/month. In addition, the fellow will be granted a research allowance of up to 4 000 euros. We offer our fellows a thriving and stimulating collegial work environment in the center of Helsinki, surrounded by libraries and University of Helsinki central campus facilities and activities.

Applicants should submit a curriculum vitae (maximum 4 pages), a list of publications, a research proposal (maximum 5 pages), and two articles or book chapters including a brief rationale for selecting the attached publications (100 words maximum per text). Applicants may also submit up to 3 letters of reference. The final selection will be made by the Director of the HCAS at the recommendation of the programme selection committee.
