

DENVI Selection Criteria

The Doctoral Programme in Interdisciplinary Environmental Sciences (DENVI) evaluates all applications for post-graduate study rights in accordance with the following criteria:

- Scientific relevance and ambition of the research topic, and the use of relevant methodology in the research plan
- Motivation and CV of the applicant including success in previous studies
- Thematic suitability of the research topic to the doctoral program profile
- Funding plan and feasibility of the thesis project within the intended timeframe (full-time work)
- Demonstration of adequate knowledge in the relevant fields and potential of the applicant to develop into an independent researcher
- Supervisory and follow-up of progress arrangements, quality of the research environment
- The applicant must have a supervisor and a professor responsible for the application at the application stage
